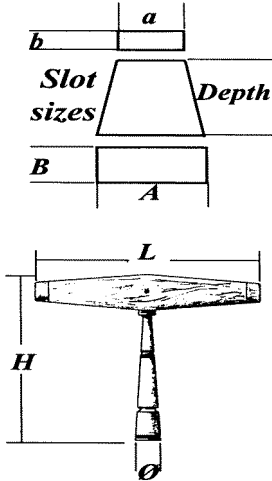

The top of your tuning pin should fit at least half-way into the slot so that the hammer stays on when you have your cup of tea.

The handle is usually made of Ebony or Rio Rosewood depending on availability, with shaft and strikers cast in bronze. There are two lengths of handle; either can be supplied with the shank off-set giving increased leverage and better access for those awkwardly placed pins near the lid. There is also an 'economy' 90mm handle of hardwood not available offset nor with strikers. Ref. 84.1x, 84.20,21 & 84.31 are available with either standard or short shanks. Ref. 84.2x sizes are provided with a stiffer shank. Other sizes can be made (**send a pin!**), including those for square harp pins. A very short (35mm) shank is available for some sizes, usually requested for square pianos.

The slot sizes, detailed above, are as follows:

- Ref. **84.11** Small pins
- Ref. **84.12** Delaruelle 3.5, 4.0, 4.5mm; Vogel 3.5 & 4.0mm & most old harpsichords
- Ref. **84.13** Fits larger traditional pins (Zuckerman 4.15mm)
- Ref. **84.14** Fits even larger traditional pins (1970's Rubios!)
- Ref. **84.21** Vogel 4.5 mm & most early pianos (~1760-1790)
- Ref. **84.22** Vogel 5.0 mm & most early pianos (~1780 - 1810)
- Ref. **84.23** Vogel 5.5 mm & most pianos ~1800-1835
- Ref. **84.24** For later pianos having large thin-headed pins
- Ref. **84.25** For later pianos having large fat-headed pins
- Ref. **84.26** fits later Broadwood pins All the other late pianos???
- Ref. **84.31** Fits those square headed zither pins beautifully
