


The handle is usually made of hardwood, with shaft and strikers cast in silicon bronze. There are two lengths of handle; either can be supplied with the shank offset giving increased leverage and better access for those awkwardly placed pins near the lid. There is also an 'economy' 90mm handle of hardwood not available offset nor with strikers . Ref. 84.1x, 84.20,21 & 84.31 are available with either standard or short shanks. Ref. 84.2x sizes are provided with a stiffer shank. Other sizes can be made (send a pin!), including those for square harp pins. A very short (35mm) shank is available for some sizes, usually requested for square pianos.
